Leadership Letter to YWAM—October 2007

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I am struggling to find the words that will give this message the importance it deserves. All I can do is ask you to read this carefully and prayerfully because it is about YWAM's destiny at this point in history. What I have to say, I say on behalf of Team3 and the Global Leadership Team, and it should impact your life and leadership. Please pass this message on to all your staff and students. Feel free to make copies of it, but more importantly, take it before the Lord and ask him to empower you to communicate it to those you lead.

As you know, we recently concluded the GLT meeting, the Asia and Pacific Staff Conference and the University of the Nations Workshop. The Holy Spirit often chooses these times when we gather to speak to us and He certainly did this year. I want to convey the impact and implications of the Word of the Lord in this letter and in others to follow.

We are entering a season unlike anything we have experienced until now. It will be characterized by people coming to faith in Jesus all over the world, growth like we have never seen, greater vision than we have ever had, more of the power of God at work in us and through us, and a call to greater holiness. Tom Bloomer summarized all this when he spoke to us from Joshua 5 and said that

God had revealed to him that we had “crossed over into the promised land.”

I would urge you to read Joshua 5 and ask the Lord to give you insight into how it applies to you, the part of YWAM you lead and to our whole family. You will see that this is a time when we begin to take the heritage God has prepared for us. It is a time when God will purify us. It is a beginning of greater battles, but at the same time we will experience more of God’s clear leading and power. It is a time of lining up with the Commander of the Lord’s army.

Seven years ago, Tom had a Word from the Lord from this same part of scripture. He compared YWAM to the 2 ½ tribes of Israel that did not cross over into the land God had promised. God was saying through Tom that many of us had settled in satisfying, comfortable places but that, if we would just stir ourselves up, God had more for us.

I can’t tell you how relieved I am! Over the past several years, I have received many messages from intercessors and prophets who all have the same question: “Will YWAM stir itself up to become all that God called it to be or will it settle for much less?” We now have the answer to that question: “YES! We will press into God for all that He has for us. We will not turn back and shrink from the impossible challenges that lie ahead. We will do the possible and God will do the impossible.”

The key to taking all the “land” that God has promised is simple, child-like obedience, giving up our tendency to take things into our own hands. (Think about what it must have been like to take on the mighty, fortified city of Jericho by just walking around it.) I hope you and all those you lead are regularly asking the Lord what He wants you to do. Simple acts of obedience lead to the greatest results.

He also want to obey God as a global movement and we believe He is calling us to united prayer again. Do you remember the way we prayed together for 50 days a few years ago? I believe our obedience to that call is one of the main reasons why God is saying we have “crossed over”.

AS A RESULT, FOR THE NEXT FEW YEARS, WE WANT TO PRAY TOGETHER AS A GLOBAL FAMILY ON THE FIRST THURSDAY OF EVERY MONTH. WE WILL START ON JANUARY 3RD.

Will you please think and pray about how to prepare your team or community for these prayer times? On behalf of Team3 and the leadership of YWAM, I will be sending you monthly information to help you lead out in prayer. You will get prayer themes, teaching articles, ideas about how to lead and other resources. I would also like to be able to send challenging monthly teachings to *every* YWAMer, so when you receive notice in November on how all your staff can participate, please encourage all of them to sign up!

I’m asking you to please begin to prepare for a regular, monthly commitment to pray together with the YWAM family around the world. Additionally, I also really need your practical, financial help. I have a good team helping me with this project. Our goal is to get in touch with every YWAMer by email and to collect all the prayer material, testimonies and other resources and make them very easily available. We will incur costs as a result of this effort.

GLT members took up a sacrificial offering to demonstrate their commitment and their conviction that God is in this plan to pray together.
